**WINNER WILL BE ANNOUNCED BY MARCH 1, 2023**

One High School winner will receive a cash prize of \$500 plus the opportunity to perform your song live at a JAS Café event. One Middle School winner will receive a cash prize of \$500 and up to four honorable mention winners will receive a cash prize of \$100.

## **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:**

- Students are encouraged to submit an original song from any music genre.
- Submissions shall include: an audio or video recording, a lyric sheet and student submission info. Please include name, age, grade, school, email address.
- Students may submit a maximum of two songs each.
- Plagiarism of copyrighted material is illegal. It is the responsibility of the songwriter to assure that music submitted is not copyrighted.
