SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- Students are encouraged to submit an original song from any music genre.
- Submissions shall include: an audio or video recording, a lyric sheet and student submission info. Please include name, age, grade, school, email address.
- Students may submit a maximum of two songs each.
- Plagiarism of copyrighted material is illegal. It is the responsibility of the songwriter to assure that music submitted is not copyrighted.
