Your Donor tickets and parking pass are transferable and can be given to guests if you are unable to attend. Please be sure to let your guests know that they <u>MUST</u> have your tickets and parking pass in order to be admitted to the Donor areas.

## **IMPORTANT - NEW TICKET DELIVERY!**

**NEW THIS YEAR** - JAS will implement a new delivery system for your Donor/ VIP tickets. All VIP tickets will now be delivered through the JAS / AXS Mobile ID app, which will need to be downloaded to your smart phone (instructions below). Your tickets will be in the app as a QR code that will be scanned off your phone upon entry into the Donor/VIP area. **Please review the instructions below on how to retrieve your tickets and FAQ regarding the new system.** We recommend you do this as soon as you get the email notifying you that your tickets have been sent to the JAS / AXS app so you don't have any issues or they can be resolved before you get to the Experience. There is limited cell service once you get on site so please do this before you get to the site.

# **Donor Parking**

If you purchased parking\* with your VIP passes you should have received your Donor parking pass in the mail. These were mailed out by August 11th.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR PARKING PASS TO CONFIRM YOUR LOCATION.

**TWO CREEKS LOT:** There will be a free shuttle service to and from with drop-off/pick-up at the Snowmass Club Golf Clubhouse, easy walking distance to the Donor entrance.

# **Donor Seating: What to Expect**

### NATIONAL COUNCIL:

Seating for National Council Members is located in the front 2/3 of the Gold Section, closest to the stage and down the center, primarily at high-top tables or in the National Council tent on the 2nd loor Upper Deck seating.

- National Council Members will have access to the National Council Host Hospitality Tent and the Upper Deck Viewing & Lounge with additional food stations, an elevated experience. \**NEW THIS YEAR: JAS is adding a 3rd Floor Deck/Lounge Area that National Council Members will have access to.*
- National Council Box Area will be **reserved for 15 minutes** after the 3pm shows begin. After that, the areas will be available to Gold Donor ticket-holders (applies for the 3pm show only).

#### GOLD DONOR 3-DÂY PASSES

Receive reserved high-top table seating in the back 1/3 and stage right of the Gold section, all catered food, and premium open bars; in addition:

• GOLD Standing Room Area located just behind NC Box Area in front of stage area: approximately the 10th row and center stage.

#### **GOLD SRO DONOR 3-DAY PASSES**

Receive all access included in the Silver Donor Pass (listed below); in addition access to:

• GOLD Standing Room Area located just behind NC Box Area in front of stage area: approximately the 10th row and center stage.

#### SILVER DONOR 3-DAY

Includes open "Bistro Style" Patio & Enclave and access to the JAS 'Lift' (elevated platform) located behind the soundboard seating, all catered food, and premium open bars. The Silver Standing Room Area is located front row to the side of the stage next to the Gold Section.

# **Donor Tent, Food & Beverage**

*NEW THIS YEAR* - Aspen Snowmass Catering will be preparing the delicious food options served in the VIP/Donor area. Donor-area staff will circulate with live-cooking station selections.

- Dinner will be served between the 5pm and headlining acts.
- In addition to the nightly selections, the Donor Patio Grill will be open daily from 3pm-7pm with great grilled fare!
- Desserts and coffee will also be available after food stations are done serving.

The Donor open bar features a full line of premium beverages & cocktails, including specialty drinks from Woody Creek Distillers, Gray Whale Gin, Don Julio and more. Please be prepared to present your ID.

# **VIP Security Measures:**



## **Driving Directions**

#### From Brush Creek Road (Intercept Lot):

- Enter the roundabout and continue through to Highline Drive towards Owl Creek for 0.5 miles
- Turn RIGHT onto Owl Creek Rd.
- Turn LEFT into the Two Creeks parking lot

#### From Owl Creek Road (Aspen):

- Turn LEFT onto Owl Creek Rd. (you've gone too far if you make it to the roundabout)
- Turn LEFT into the Two Creeks parking lot
